Information We May Collect From You

We may collect and process the following data about you:

Information that you provide by filling in forms on our sites. This includes information provided at the time of registering to us requesting further information or services. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with one of our sites. If you contact us we may keep a record of that correspondence; we may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them and details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, your IP address weblogs and other communication data and the resource.

IP Addresses & Cookies.

We may collect information about your cookies, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type for system administration. This is statistical data about our user's browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.
